Notice of two councillor vacancies

Notice is hereby given that there are **two councillor vacancies** for the Holme Hale Parish. The Council is able to fill these vacancies by co-option (by formal vote from the Parish Councillors).

If you are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor, please make your application in writing giving your reasons for wanting to join the Council and a brief CV about yourself.

Membership of the Council is open to electors who are citizens of any state in the European Union or of the Commonwealth and;

- whose residence is in Holme Hale or within three miles of Holme Hale, or;
- whose principal place of work is in Holme Hale; and
- who is not disqualified (by reason of a criminal record, bankruptcy or involvement in corrupt practices).

Councillors are expected to attend regular bi-monthly meetings usually on the first Monday of every other month, subject to occasional rescheduling, and any additional meetings as may be agreed. Previous experience is not essential and training for Councillors can be provided.

Councillors must be comfortable to represent the electors of Holme Hale in raising and discussing those issues of interest and concern on which the Parish Council is empowered to act.

There is no deadline for the positions but consideration of applications will be made on a rolling basis and those received will each be considered by the Parish Council at its public meetings until the position is filled.
